### **2022 Annual Meeting Minutes**

The membership of the Estacado Federal Credit Union met on September 15, 2022, for their annual meeting at the Lea County Event Center in Hobbs, NM. Members signing in were 109. Chair Bobby Goad welcomed the attendees and asked Yesenia Arroyo to lead the Pledge of Allegiance and a member presented the invocation.

Mr. Goad introduced the Board of Directors and Supervisory Committee. He praised the staff for another year of good service to the members of Estacado FCU despite the challenges this year. Mr. Roddenberry introduced the staff.

Having determined that a quorum for the business meeting was present, Mr. Goad asked for a reading of the minutes of the 2021 meeting. Secretary Brenda Garcia reviewed the minutes, which were approved as presented after a motion to approve was made by Angela Cranfill and Seconded by Carol Streber. The Chair's report was given by Mr. Goad and the Supervisory Committee report by LeeAnn Patman.

Mr. Roddenberry presented the State of the Credit Union (Financial Reports) and his annual CEO Report. Overall, 2021 was a good year with improved income, savings growing over 7%, but loans declined 2.8% due to COVID limitations. Financials were approved with a motion by Brittny Huffman and a Second by LeeAnn Patman.

There being no unfinished business, the meeting moved on to New Business. Board Chair Bobby Goad then presented the results of the election of Board members. Four members were nominated for three positions and ballots were mailed to all eligible primary adult members. Elected to the Board were Brenda Garcia, Sarah Williams, and Ava Benge who received the highest number of votes.

The business meeting ended with a motion to adjourn heard from Sarah Williams and a second from Ricky Dunlap.

Those present then participated in drawing the Annual Meeting cash prize giveaway.
